The MTS ROV Committee scholarships are open to MTS members who are college graduate students, college undergraduates and high school seniors who intend to pursue a college curriculum directed toward a career in marine/ocean sciences or engineering, or a closely related field with an emphasis on ROV technology.

To qualify for the MATE/MTS ROV scholarship the applicant must either attend a MATE Partner college or university or have participated in a MATE ROV Competition.

- You *must* use the scholarship award for tuition only in the 2016-2017 academic year.
- **Scholarship money is sent to your school's Bursar Office, not directly to scholarship recipients. Scholarship funds are applicable to tuition expenses only and issued via check in U.S. dollars.**



A Certified Electronic Transcript is preferred (*a Certified Electronic Transcript is secure, certified PDF that is password protected and has been digitally signed and certified*). The Certified Electronic Transcript must be emailed to ROVsScholarships@mtsociety.org by the school registrar's office. Please note, the transcript must be the most recent one from the school only. Do not send previous years.
- ✓ One-page essay about your interest in ROVs or underwater work that furthers the use of ROVs
- ✓ Three personal references - Names and phone numbers only
- ✓ Written letter of recommendation from a current teacher or counselor (must be scanned and emailed to ROVsScholarships@mtsociety.org)

Applications that are incomplete or fail to meet the requirements will not be accepted.

All documents, including the letter of recommendation Applications must be submitted online no later than Wednesday, April 20, 2016.
