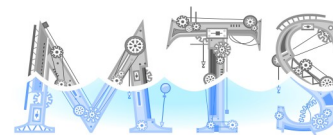


2016 NW Marine Technology Summit

GUIDELINES

- Topic must be related to marine technology
- All posters should be mounted on foam board
- Posters requiring support should be no larger than 24 x 36"
- Posters on tri-fold foam board should be no larger than 36 x 48"
- You will need to register for the Summit to present your poster. Early registration is available through poster submission deadline.
- You are requested to setup your poster by 7:30 am on Monday and to be present at your poster during breaks

- 10/01 Submit image and dimensions of poster
- 10/10 Setup poster by 7:30 am
